SUBJECT: FOOD SERVICE IN STATE OWNED/DEPARTMENT USED FACILITIES		

Definitions:

As used in this Policy:

- (1) "Food Service" includes restaurant, cafeteria, snack bar, vending machines, for food and beverages and goods and services customarily offered in connection with them.
- (2) "Public office building" means facilities owned by the State of Utah and used by the State Department of Human Services primarily as governmental offices.

Policy: In furtherance of Utah Code Ann. 55-5-1 et.seq., when the Department of Human Services (DHS) proposes to operate or continue a food service in a public office building, DHS shall first attempt in good faith to make an agreement with the Division of Services for the Blind and Visually Impaired to operate the food service without payment of rent. DHS may not offer or grant to any other party a contract or concession to operate the food service unless DHS determines in good faith that the Division of Services for the Blind and Visually Impaired is not willing to or cannot satisfactorily provide the food service.
